Curriculum

The primary objective of the classes which take place at Al-Nur Islamic Center is to instill within the attendees those moral concepts which they may never come across otherwise. With the understanding that honesty, morality, compassion and all other essential qualities are slowly fading out in the face of popular culture, we strive to bring about the understanding that humanity is at loss without them. How much a student has benefited from the classes is measured in terms of the amount of material he or she has grasped and has been able to implement in his or her life. The material to be covered is:

- (1) Morals and Manners as demonstrated in the Quran and life of the Prophet (pbuh).
- (2) Education against drugs and alcohol.
- (3) Understanding history as an eternal lesson.
- (4) Personal and spiritual benefits of engaging in virtuous and charitable deeds.
- (5) Clearing of misconceptions in regards to Islam.
- (6) Viewing the life of the Prophet (pbuh) as an ideal way of life.
- (7) Time management.
- (8) Introductory concepts of worship.
- (9) Moral obligations of citizenship

General Schedule

For each of the two hour class meetings, the schedule below is followed.

First Hour – Lecture with visuals regarding the topic to be discussed.

15 Minute Break

30 Minutes – Getting accustomed with the Arabic alphabet.

Final Fifteen Minutes – Open discussion to help deal with any concerns in regards to the class or simply issues one may have across during the course of the week.

Curriculum Specifics

While most of the books to be used are still under review, the following books are currently employed:

Quranic Reading

“Noorani Qaida” – an introduction to the Arabic alphabets.

Islamic Studies

Basic traditions of the Prophet (pbuh).

Other texts which are to be employed will all be of similar nature as the above mentioned, i.e. short and concise and limited to single subjects.
